From The Pastor's Desk

Readings: The tradition of having a prophet was important at this time in Israel. Elijah was to pick one to succeed him. Elisha seems unlikely, a wealthy farm boy. Twelve yoke of oxen could be a sign of wealth or that he was well established. He left it all and followed Elijah. The responsorial assures us why we can leave all to follow the Lord. "You are my inheritance, O Lord." It tells us that the Lord does care for us and give the positives. Paul saw the Law, the Pentateuch, as a burden, especially for the non Jews. Some were encouraging, even demanding, that they follow the Law. You can see that emotions at times ran high, "biting and tearing one another to pieces." Don't give in to these cravings, but be guided by the spirit.

In the Gospel, Jesus is determined to go to Jerusalem, even though it meant suffering and death. The Samaritans lack of hospitality would not distract him. He assures his followers that at times the journey will be rough and he is asking for dedication. A bit of different emphasis for the Responsorial Psalm.
